AESA EXAM TRAINING

This course will prepare you to take the official exam of the State Air Safety Agency, of a Drone pilot in a Open Category (A2). We will provide you with the necessary knowledge to be able to take the official test and obtain the certification that will allow you to operate throughout the Spanish and European territory.

REQUIREMENTS

- Be at least 16 years of age.
- Valid ID/ passport
- Be registered in the electronic headquarters of AESA (State Agency for Aviation Safety)

OBJECTIVE

The objective of this course is to train and prepare the student, working on the necessary contents and programs that are required in the Open Category (A2) to take the official test of AESA (State Agency for Air Safety), and Obtain the certificate that will allow you to operate within the specific category scenarios throughout the Spanish and European territory.

In the open category of subcategory A2, it is allowed to fly near people outside the operation, at a horizontal distance of at least 30 meters, being able to reduce to a minimum of 5 meters, as long as the aircraft features the low speed mode. In this case, the area of the operation will have to be marked and the risks of the operation evaluated. Pilots conducting open A2 operations will need to be familiar with the manufacturer's user manual, as well as be in possession of the drone pilot competency certificate. To do this, you must take a corresponding online exam at AESA, and a self-practical training with the aircraft.

DURATION

The approximate duration of the course is about 10 hours, although it will depend on the availability of the students.



DEVELOPMENT

WORLD AVIATION FLIGHT ACADEMY provides in the Training Manual for this course, all the means and necessary knowledge for the student to be prepared to face the official exam of 30 questions which will be done online at the State Air Safety Agency.

Regarding self-practical training, the pilot must carry out as many flights as he considers necessary to acquire a reasonable level of aptitude to operate the aircraft; This self-practice will be done before the online theory exam. This course is 100% online.
