ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Requirements to apply to this A320 Type Rating program.

First Type Rating Applicant pilots:

- Flight certificate of 70 PIC.
- UPRT program.
- ME + IR qualification.
- CPL License (ATPL Frozeen).
- Class 1 Medical Certificate.
- MCC certificate.
- Level of English ICAO 4.

Applicant pilots with Type Rating:

- ME + IR rating
- Class 1 Medical Certificate
- ICAO English level 4



THEORETICAL PHASE

Program structured in 18 days / 6 hours per day of study load, in which training in procedures and systems, progress tests and the final exam will be carried out.

- Total 108h.

FASE SIMULADOR

- The advanced phase of simulator training consists of 8 sessions of 4 hours of FFS Level D A320.
- Total of 32 hours of training, where 16 hours will be performed as FP, and 16 hours as PM.
- Extra session of 1h per student for the completion of the UPRT certification.
- Verification exam in a last 4-hour session.

BASE FLIGHT TRAINING

In the flight training for multi-pilot aircraft, a number of take-offs and take-offs will be determined, which will vary depending on the experience of the pilot and the characteristics of the aircraft previously flown:

- Pilot with more than 500 hours in an aircraft of similar size and performance must make at least 4 landings where a Go-Around will be carried out, and at least one of the landings with a complete stop.
- In all other cases that do not comply with this experience, normally at least 6 landings plus a Go Around and in the same way, a landing with a complete stop must be completed

PROGRAMA ZERO FLIGHT TIME TRAINING

A pilot conducting instruction in a ZFTT course must have completed, in a multi-pilot turbojet aircraft certified according to CS-25 standards or equivalent airworthiness code or in a multi-pilot turboprop aircraft with a maximum certified take-off mass of not less than 10 tons or a certified passenger seating configuration of more than 19 passengers, at least:

- 1500 flight hours or 250 route sectors if a qualified FFS at the provisional CG, C or C level is used during the course.
- 500 flight hours or 100 route sectors if an FFS qualified at DG, D level is used during the course.

An additional session will be held at FFS, led by a TRI who will act as a Pilot. This session will take place within 21 days of the skill test at the FFS.

In order to apply to this program, the following requirements must be met:

- Completion of FFS, additional ZFTT session, within 21 days of completion of the skill test in FFS.
- Start of the Line Flying Under Supervision within 21 days following the completion of the skill test in FFS.

- Realization of the first four takeoffs and landings within the Line Flying Under Supervision, with a TRI in the Pilot position.

If these requirements are not met, a training flight will be required based on the experience of each pilot.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Special attention will be paid to the briefing, and de-briefing where the flight profile and the objectives of this session are carefully prepared. All the necessary considerations will be taken by the instructor regarding the learning objectives and competencies.
