





REQUIREMENTS

- Valid Private Pilot Licence (PPL/A) or Commercial Pilot Licence (CPL/A).
- Class I or II Medical Certificate (depending on the licence).
- 30 hours in single-engine piston aeroplanes of which:
 - 5 in the last 6 months before the entry test.
 - 20 Cross-country hours.
- Take a flight test with an Instructor from the School.

OBJETIVE

The Airplane Flight Instructor Rating Fl(A) enables the holder to give theoretical and flight instruction to student pilots undertaking the Private Pilot Pilot (PPL/A) course and/or the and/or the Commercial Pilot (CPL/A) course (provided the necessary requirements are met).

DURATION

- Theoretical training: The estimated duration of the theoretical course is 7 weeks.
- **Practical training:** The estimated duration of the practical training is 1 to 5 weeks.

TOTAL: 12 weeks.

DEVELOPMENT

The IF training course is divided into 3 parts:

- 1. Teaching & Learning course.
- 2. Refresher theoretical instruction.
- 3. Flying instruction.

THEORETICAL & FLIGHT TRAINING

THEORETICAL TRAINING

- 25 hours Teaching & Learning.
- 100 hours Teaching Programme to refresh knowledge of the subjects of the Private Pilot syllabus + Theoretical aircraft course.
- Theoretical Test (Classroom Presentation).
- Practical Training.

PRACTICAL TRAINING

- 30 hours of flight (Dual) (in which the student acts as an Instructor teaching the Instructor).
- Flight Test (With Examiner).

NOTE

All practical training hours are REAL flight hours.

QUALIFICATION OBTAINED

Airplane Flight Instructor Fl(A).

INCLUDED IN THE COURSE

- Theoretical lessons.
- Practical (flying) lessons.
- Exam flight time.

NOT INCLUDED IN THE COURSE

- Examiner's fee for the theory test and the flight test.
- Test flight required for entry to the course.
